



An average shower uses 8-14 litres of water per minute, by saving water in the shower you'll be helping the environment and your local community by protecting one of our most precious resources.

How to use your smart shower timer



Step 1: Install your shower timer

Mount the bracket onto the device, the shower timer will automatically go online without needing to connect to WIFI. Place the shower timer onto the wall of the shower cubical using the double-sided adhesive tape and remove the blue plastic on the front of the timer.



Step 2: Take your first shower

Once the shower timer is mounted on the wall of the shower area it will be activated by moisture from turning the shower on.

The display on the front of the timer will indicate the shower length.



Step 3: Scan to see your data

Use your mobile phone camera or QR reader to read the QR code on the front of the shower timer - this should be done 5 days after installing the timer so that we can collect bench mark data.

You don't need to download an app, simply scan the QR code

- Keep track of your water usage
- Compare your weekly water stats

We will share water saving hints and tips along the way with useful information and ways you can get involved to support your local community with water saving competitions.
